Big Dog Show

- David Hall is donating the forklift, Dale Rogers would like a photo of the equipment to be sure it is appropriate for the installation
- Some people have donated to the Bartlet Mall Commission as opposed to the Parks Conservancy for the Dog Show, so the amount we've raised is slightly unclear
- Walt has contacted the Deck, Packaging Specialties
- Andy has received positive feedback from Institution for Savings, the Provident Bank, and Muddy River

- Andy is going to contact several PR firms, perhaps there are potential donations
- Perhaps realtors would be interested in donating
- Ellen know of a person who owns a fundraising company called Cornerstone, who strategizes fundraising approaches for churches
- Kickstarter could be a good resource for fundraising now and in the future
- Andy will look into beginning a Kickstarter
- We have had 30 dog key chains donated and three big dogs donated for the show by Dale Rogers studio, perhaps we could make them part of the Kickstarter

Status of RFP
