Tom Hughes represented the applicant, who installed a float system. A large tree fell during a storm and was removed but no other trees were impacted by the project. The landing float that was installed is ten feet longer than that which had been approved. The change should not impact the resource area. Doug Muir moved to issue a Certificate of Compliance with a cover letter that states: 1) the increased size of the landing float is acceptable, 2) any further changes would require Conservation Commission approval, 3) the floats must be stored outside of the saltmarsh and coastal bank and 4) any storage of floats on the site must be coordinated with the Conservation Commission. David Vine seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Tom Hughes represented the applicant, who is proposing to add a swimming pool and deck and replace the plant materials in the terraced area between the house and the river. Some of the proposed work would be within the 25-foot no-disturb zone but would be exempt under the ordinance. The terraced area is largely made of ledge and would be planted with native species to add habitat value. An existing shed has been removed. The slab under the shed is attached to the bedrock and would be retained to provide support for the new deck. A site visit took place on October 4 at which the Commission members asked that additional plant materials be installed on the rock wall in two locations. Steve Moore moved to close the public hearing. Dan Warchol seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
