Demolition Delay Historical Significance Determination

The applicants are proposing to demolish a small extension at the rear of a Greek Revival row house. Both the main house and the one-story ell appear on the 1884 maps. The extension has no foundation and may have been originally used as a summer kitchen. The addition that would replace it would be on a larger footprint but would mimic the existing form. The addition would not be visible from the street.

Stephen Dodge moved the structure is historically significant. Ron Ziemba seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Stephen Dodge moved to accept the plans as submitted and allow the demolition of the rear extension of the structure. Glenn Richards seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
