# Gloria Braunhardt Bike/Pedestrian Trail Accessibility Upgrades Section 106 Review

Jerry Mullins, President of the Parker River Clean Water Association, described the plans to improve the Gloria Braunhardt Bike Path. The path is the one accessible trail of the six trails running through the land over which the association has jurisdiction. The land to the west of the landfill is a listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Primitive farm remains can be found in the area, which includes the Common Pasture. A \$50,000 grant has been obtained to upgrade the bike path, which is comprised of three lanes. The two outer lanes would be ground up and the land returned to its natural state. A grass berm would border the path to the protect the wetlands from contaminants. Birch trees that overhang the path would be cut and their stumps left in place. Every effort would be made to disturb the ground as little as possible.

Glenn Richards moved to authorize the chair to write a letter stating the NHC supports the plan to improve the Gloria Braunhardt Bike Path and the project would not negatively impact the historic resources of the Common Pasture. Stephen Dodge seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.
