- 1. TRAN066\_01\_13\_2020 NHS exterior Woodwork Phase III \$110,903, CIP Nock/Molin Parking Lot \$8,997.87 to CIP Sidewalk Repairs \$119,900.87.
  - a. Mr. Manning noted that the estimate made by the design firm for Phase IV of the High School exterior woodwork project had increased subsequent to the appropriation request and that the Administration needed more time to develop a new appropriation request. Therefor, the Administration requested that we Receive and File TRAN066.
  - **b.** Attached find the updated 1/16/2020 funding summary on the project provided by the Finance Director.
  - **c.** Committee voted 3-0 to recommend that the Council Receive and File this measure.
- 2. ORDR164\_01\_13\_2020 Connors Scholarship Gift Acceptance \$5,000.
  - a. Mr. Manning reported that the Connors Scholarship grant is an annual gift that the Council had received in the previous year. At that time, the Finance Director had suggested that the order specify that the Council receive the gift every year without bringing it before the Council. The Council decided, instead, to have the request come before the Council each year. Thus, it is before the Council.
  - **b.** The Chair requested information on the scholarship. The Finance Director provided the information subsequent to the meeting. It is attached.
  - c. Committee voted 3-0 to recommend that the Council approve acceptance of the gift.
- 3. APPT138 01 13 2020 Ethan Manning, Director of Finance.
  - **a.** The Chair noted that he had worked with Mr. Manning for six years and that the other two members of the Committee had worked with him over the past two

- years. He also noted that Mr. Manning was knowledgeable and ever willing to provide Committee members with information and his assistance.
- **b.** Ward 1 Councillor Zeid asked Mr. Manning for his opinion as to how relationships with the Council were going. Mr. Manning said he welcomed the greater attention to budgetary details evidenced by Council members recently. He thought it was a positive development.
- c. Ward 1 Councillor Zeid asked what the Finance Director's opinion was of the City's bonding capacity and constraints. Mr. Manning said he thought it was likely that the City would have to seek a bond override if we were to fund both the fire station and youth center in addition to other capital projects. In terms of debt obligations as a proportion of total expenditures and revenue, Mr. Manning thought the City was in good shape. The problem arises in attempting to meet new capital obligations, fund the rest of the operating budget, and stay within the Proposition 2 ½ constraints.
- d. At Large Councillor Khan asked if individual committee members could ask Mr. Manning questions without going through the Chair. Mr. Manning said he was happy to do so.
- **e.** Committee voted 3-0 to recommend that the Council approve Mr. Manning's three-year appointment as Finance Director.
