

PAID PARKING INFORMATION

CITY OF NEWBURYPORT



The City of Newburyport has had paid parking lots since May 2011. Below please find some useful information on the pay by plate kiosks, times of operations, locations, and more.

PARKING LOTS

- **Green St. Lot** (ZONE 2150)
Resident Lot Permit Valid / \$1.50/HR - 3HR Limit
- **State St. Lot** (ZONE 2151)
Resident Lot Permit Valid \$1.00/HR - 3HR Limit
- **Prince Place Lot** (ZONE 2152)
Resident & Employee Lot Permit Valid \$1.50/HR - All Day Parking
(Except in designated spaces)
- **Hales Ct. Lot** (ZONE 2156)
Resident & Employee Lot Permit Valid \$1.50/HR - All Day Parking
- **NRA East Lot** (ZONE 2153)
Resident & Employee Lot Permit Valid \$1.00/HR - All Day Parking
- **NRA West Lot** (ZONE 2154)
Resident & Employee Permit Valid \$1.00/HR - All Day Parking
- **Waterfront Trust Lot** (ZONE 2155)
No permits valid here \$1.00/HR - All Day Parking

The parking lot kiosks operate;

Jan 1 – Mar 31 Monday through Saturday from 8 am to 6 pm and Sunday from 12 pm to 6 pm.

Apr 1 – Dec 31 Monday through Saturday from 8 am to 8 pm and Sunday from 12 pm to 6 pm.

PARKING LOT PERMITS

The parking office issues yearly discounted parking permits to residents, senior residents, and employees.

Time limits DO apply to permit holders.

Your license plate serves as your permit identifier and windshield stickers are no longer issued.

These permits are not for on-street parking; there is no fee to park on-street.

Permits are **renewable annually on July 1st** and can be purchased or renewed online at **newburyportpermits.rmcpay.com**.

The following **fees** apply:

- Residents; \$15.00/year
- Senior Residents; \$5.00/year (65 years of age or older)
- Employees; \$240.00/year or \$60/quarter
(Employee permits also include use of Titcomb Street Entrance Garage)

PARKING GARAGE

(ZONE 2157)

Resident, Employee, Non-resident Garage Permit Valid

\$1.00/HR – kiosks operate 24 hours/day;

No more than 7 consecutive days

PARKING GARAGE PERMITS

Permits allow a vehicle to park in in the parking garage without paying a fee for each use.

Your license plate serves as your permit identifier and windshield stickers are no longer issued.

These permits are not for on-street parking; there is no fee to park on-street.

Permits can be purchased or renewed online at

newburyportpermits.rmcpay.com.

The following **fees** apply:

- Residents; \$60/month (30 days) or \$720/year (full year)
- Non-Residents; \$80/month (30 days) or \$960/year (full year)

WHERE ARE THE PAY BY PLATE KIOSKS?

There are one or more kiosks in each parking lot. There is an easily identifiable sign “**Pay Here**” above each kiosk. The seven parking lots are identified on the map on the reverse side of this brochure.

- Pay by phone, through the *Passport App*, available at <http://m.ppprk.com>.
