COMM397 Appointment of Laura Vlasuk as Health Director

Laura Vlasuk attended the zoom call to share with the committee her priorities for the upcoming year.

One: Focus on Certificates of Habitability....focusing on status of apartments, landlord issues, etc

Two: Catch up on inspections that might have lapsed during Covid

Three: Review City ORDN's and make suggestions for clarity and updates with new regulations.

Overall, the committee welcomed her on her first day.

Committee: Vote to Send to CC as a R&F 3-0

Visit from Paul Hogg Harbor Master.

Paul Hogg attended the zoom call to share with the committee his priorities for the upcoming year.

First he mentioned that he is anticipating another busy year. With the weather, he is planning to load the docks early (week 4/4). Paul's Priorities are

1. Main Dredge and Side Dredge: Main dredge is via ACoE, Side Dredge will be in partnership with Salisbury, KP Law drafting agreement. Sand to be placed at North Jetty and Reservation Terr. Is this the time to reset the Navigational Channel Markings? (and is state/federal help needed?).
2. Bulkhead: This is a critical piece of everyone's downtown. HarborMaster is involved in all the discussions as to how to move this project forward.
3. Mkt Landing Park Plan and advocating for an open commercial pier.
4. Impact of Riverfest (7/24)
5. Coast Guard change of Command. CG wil swap out personnel this year and HarborMaster helps with the educating of the new personnel to the area.
6. Parking Program out at PI. Exploring options to bring some consistency to the parking program on the island.

Committee: Will Update the Council via Committee Report

COMM 396 Ltr from Stephen Comley.

Mr Comley submitted a communication asking the City to send a letter to a variety of officials who oversee the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station. Mr Comely did not attend the meeting.

It is unclear what the actual message is that Mr Comley would like us to convey. Most of his previous documentation he has submitted has been obtained. For ex, he was asking oversight officials for a public hearing on the evacuation plan, and that is scheduled for 4/9.
