APPL 67 Lions Club Road Race 8/2

Order 331 Loading Zone on Green St

Sponsored by Cnlr Donahue. Asking for a temporary suspension of the loading zone from 5/1-10/31 to accommodate outside dining at Mission Oak. Owner at Mission Oak was previously in Brown's Square Park...this created some issues for both Mission Oak and the Parks Dept long term. Ask is move into an outdoor dining parklet provided the loading zone isse can be addressed.

Loading zone runs 60 ft, includes a curb cut for a dual driveway/dumpster holding. Additionally loading zone abuts the USPS drive up Mailbox. 2Hr spot will remain during this trial. Loading zones resumes 11/1/22. Suggest Mission Oak adjust timing of its deliveries to earlier in day during summer months and use a jersy barriers if parklet application is approved.

Mr Jones joined us to update us on the new developments of interest for the Parking Dept. Those items discussed included: The addition of a HP spot on Liberty, implementation of the 15min parking spots that replace the A-Frames.

Q from Cnlr Donahue? How many HP spots in total are in the city? Ans: To be researched and advise.

Mr Jones updated us on the reality that the City is losing spots in downtown—expanded Market Landing Park, plus Parklets etc. His office has been investigating expansion of the paid parking program run by the city to private lots. First up is the Daily News Lot. Both sides open to an agreement similar to how we run the PO lot. If this is successful, he anticipates expanding to 2 other lots.
