### ***ORDR 357 USACE Merrimack Rvr Noise Waiver for Dredge***

Andrew Levine and Paul Hogg (HM) present to answer questions. US Army Corp of Engineers is asking the City of Nbpt to issue a waiver to its noise ordinance so that work to dredge the river will go uninterrupted. It was pointed out that many factors can influence the dredge

project: tides, weather, environmental restrictions, etc. In order to be the most efficient, the USACE is asking for us to waive our noise ordinance.

Questions: Q notification of abutters? A. Yes, via city resources similar to hydrant flushing. Q side dredge covered? A. no. Q any description of types of noises? A. just engine noise from dredge machine.
