AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND TERM DURATION FOR THE NEWBURYPORT COUNCIL ON AGING

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Newburyport as follows:

THAT Chapter 2 Administration of the Code of Ordinances, City of Newburyport, Massachusetts, is hereby amended to read as follows, with *deletions double-stricken and in italicized*, and additions *double-underlined and italicized*:

Article III Boards, Committees, Commissions Division 2. Council on Aging

Sec. 2-81. Establishment; membership.

There is hereby established a council on aging consisting of an eleven (11) member board, a majority of which must be a least sixty (60) years of age. Members must be residents and registered veters of the city. Members shall be appointed by the mayor, subject to the consent approval of by the city council. All members currently serving on the board shall remain, subject to terms designated by the mayor in section 2-82.

Sec. 2-82. Terms of appointees.

Initially, members shall be appointed to terms in the following manner:

- Two (2) members shall be appointed for a one-year term.
- Two (2) members shall be appointed for two-year terms.
- Two (2) members shall be appointed for three-year terms.
- Two (2) members shall be appointed for four-year terms.
- Three (3) members shall be appointed for five-year terms.

As the term of each member expires, their successor shall be appointed for a term of <u>five-three</u> (<u>3</u>5) years. Terms shall expire on the last day of May. A member may be reappointed for successive terms.

Sec. 2-85. Coordinating, carrying out programs.

It shall be the duty of the council on aging to coordinate or carry out programs designed to meet problems of the aging in coordination with programs of the council on aging established under M.G.L. c. 406, § 8873.
