- Q: When will construction start?
- A: Construction is to commence Fall 2022
- Q: How long will it take to complete the project?
- A: The Contractor plans to work through the winter if weather allows and anticipates construction to last through next construction season. Then the following year, the roadway will get its final coat.
- Q: Will I lose access to my driveway?
- A: There will be times when construction limits access to driveways. The Contractor will restore access by the end of each working day. You will be given advanced notice to plan accordingly.
- Q: Will my water be shutdown?
- A: Your water may be shutoff for a short period of time. You will be given advanced notice to plan accordingly.
- Q: Can you please locate my water valve/curb stop in my yard?
- A: The Contractor will locate water valves /curb stops and paint them so they are exposed
- Q: Why is the neighborhood getting asphalt berm not granite curb?
- A: Mayor Holaday said she would fund the additional cost of granite if the construction bid price is low enough and there's enough money to fund it. The bids came in too high and we had to seek additional funds to pay for construction administration services.
- Q: Will the City impose a betterment fee on the residents after construction is complete, similar to what the City did on Low Street?
- A: No. This project is fully funded.
