City Council Chambers September 19, 2013 Minutes

1. Call to Order

3. Demolition Applications

15 Tyng Street Demolition of Real Ell

The applicant is proposing to remove a rear ell and replace it with a 22' x 24' two-story addition. The roofline would remain the same but would be higher by two feet and eight inches. The existing enclosed porch would be converted to a farmer's porch. Both the porch and the ell were additions to the main structure, which is to remain intact. The structure has been greatly modified over the years and is not timber framed. Linda Smiley moved that the structure is not historically significant. Sarah White seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved. The applicant must submit a new copy of the plans for the files, as the version that was submitted with the application was not the most recent one.

4. Minutes
