**JOB POSTING**

The Waste Water Mechanic for the City of Newburyport performs skilled technical mechanical work in connection with maintenance of all mechanical equipment and pump systems located at the wastewater facilities. An individual in this position is also expected to perform many different types of maintenance and repair work and manual labor in addition to driving CDL vehicles. A Waste Water Mechanic is responsible for maintaining and improving upon the efficiency and effectiveness of all areas under his/her direction and control.

This position requires a High School Diploma or GED with 2 -5 years of advanced training/experience in Waste Water Treatment Plant maintenance and operation systems plus mechanical/plumbing work experience, heavy vehicle driving experience; or any equivalent combination of education, experience and training. Grade 4 Wastewater Treatment Certification is preferred. Must be able to operate a computer and utilize maintenance management software. Must possess a valid driver's license and have or be able to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class B with airbrakes endorsement within the first three (3) months of employment. Must have or be able to obtain a Massachusetts Hoisting Engineer license with 2A and 1C endorsements within first six (6) months of employment. This position requires the ability to frequently lift up to 50 lbs. and occasionally lift up to 100 lbs. and must submit to CDL drug testing regulations.

This is a full-time, 40 hour per week position Monday – Friday (7am to 3pm) plus required overtime. This position is in the AFSCME Union, Grade 16, with a pay range of \$24.16 – 28.44 depending on seniority.
