- •59 Low St: best option based on location, accessibility, space, parking, utilities, cost, environmental impact
- 2022: purchased 59 Low St for \$220K
- 2022: RDA filed with Conservation Commission
- 2022-2023: worked with EGA to design the project

## The design

- Space for early education programs infant-grade 2
- •Space for youth programs/youth center grades 6-12
  - Quiet homework space (doubles as conference room)
  - Connected art space and access to outdoors
  - Flexible design to handle small events
- Space for youth and adult recreation
  - Flexible 'maker' spaces (art, STEM and cooking)
  - Multi-purpose spaces



## The design

- Administrative space 5 offices for 8FT staff
- Secure building with access control
- Lobby, snack bar and sitting area with restrooms
- Modular gym for youth, family and adult recreation
- Managed traffic flow and parking with safe crossing from middle/high school
- Separate, secure and flexible outdoor spaces
