Dear Mr. Lally:

Our meeting of May 22 and discussions at the City of Newburyport Planning Board meeting of May 23 have assisted us in defining the concerns of the City concerning Well No. 2. In order to address these concerns, it is vital for BSC, as the applicants representative, to collect all available hydrogeologic information concerning this well and the subject property, both present and historic. The following information, provided to us at your earliest convenience, is necessary to complete our review and the development of mitigation and protection measures for the City water supply.

1. Water Quality records for Well No. 2 and any other City or Regional wells to document historic conditions as they relate to the subject property and the regional groundwater quality. Data from the previous ten years, or longer if necessary, to establish long-term trends of sodium concentrations is required.
2. Logs of monitoring wells drilled for Well No. 2 and their approximate locations. Available water quality records for these wells, if any, would be of assistance.
3. Any records pertaining to the salt marsh materials used as fill on the subject property including production and monitoring well water quality, fill testing, area groundwater elevations at that time.
4. Information concerning long-term regional groundwater elevations at Well No. 2 and the project site to establish desirable site grading and elevations.


