To expand on Jon-Eric's response. I have also conducted a review on the Vanasse Associates traffic study of September 30, 2016 and would like to submit the following comments.

- 1. DPS strongly supports two roadway full access to and from the site from all users. This is important for public services (i.e. snow clearing) and other roadway maintenance required on such roads. Even though the roadway is planned to be privately owned, we have no idea if city council with accept the roadway in the future and we should design for this.
- 2. Page 6. Traffic volumes seems reasonable.
- 3. Page 8. The 22' wide minimum roadway is extremely narrow and be at least 25' wide. Prefer 28' wide which allows for one sided 8' wide parking and two 10' travel lanes.
- 4. Page 8 & 9. I cannot support an emergency access only Fire Road. This would be difficult to maintain and clear during snow events, inefficient for roadway maintenance and understand that the NBPT Fire Department has expressed concerns about unlocking a gate or mounting a "mountable curb".
- 5. Page 10. PARKING. The proposed 24' is still narrow. We must assume some on-street parking occurring on this street. (i.e. Landscapers, services vehicles)
