Dear Councilor Eigerman,

Please consider having the committee formally define "pedestrian open space." Walkability is a competitive strength for Newburyport. Any proposal for Waterfront West should be evaluated by explicitly defining the walkability goal.

To me, there are three levels of "pedestrian open space":

- 1) Open space where no vehicles are permitted (think Inn St.),
- 2) Open space where vehicles may transit, but may not park, even temporarily,
- 3) Open space where vehicles may transit, and park in, or adjacent to pedestrian walkways.

The current NED proposal uses definition 3), and claims ample open space. I urge the committee to consider adopting the definition of "pedestrian open space" as space where vehicles may transit, but there is no parking whatsoever allowed, even on a temporary basis. (Newburyport parking clerks should be allowed to enforce.)


