SECOND REVISION OF NEWBURYPORT WATERFRONT TRUST

ARTICLE III

ARTICLE III, entitled TRUST PURPOSE, is amended by adding the following paragraphs to the end thereof:

*Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the trust is organized exclusively for one or more of the following purposes: religious, charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, or educational purposes, or to foster national or international amateur sports competition (but only if no part of its activities involve the providing of facilities or equipment) or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals, as specified in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954, and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an entity exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

No substantial part of the activities of the Trust shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise provided by Internal Revenue Code section 501(h), or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 5

ARTICLE IV, Section 5 is amended by adding the following paragraph to the end thereof:

"No part of the net earnings of the Trust shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director, officer of the Trust, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Trust), and no member, trustee, officer shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Trust assets upon dissolution of the Trust".

ARTICLE XV

ARTICLE XV shall be added to the Trust, as follows:

"The fiscal year of the Trust shall end on June 30."
