Questions from Councillor Wallace (CW) about the level of involvement with the Health Dept? Who drives inspections etc? Dr replied that BoH involved more than Health Dept to also include sanitation, water quality, protecting water sources.

Question from Councillor Lane (CL) wrt Merrimack River? Dr stated BOH involved in the monitoring and notifications, and this will continue as new programs evolve.

Motion to approve (CW), 2^{nd} (CL), vote 3-0

Comm216 Letter RE Ban Glyphosate: Chair summarized the letter as a concern by Ms Masis to take our existing restrictions(city bans use on public property and parks dept) further to include the private sale and use of Glyphosate. Current MA Law (ML Chapter 132B MA pesticide Control Act) prevents the City from further restrictions on private use. However it was suggested that we would refer this matter to BOH (Dr Slocum) who would bring before Board to possibly set guidelines for those citizens looking for alternatives for Glyphosate. (A similar program was instituted in the Town of Marblehead). Motion to keep this in committee while we await the results of our referral to BoH and any additional info Ms Masis would submit. Vote 3-0.
