- Tree Warden has typically been DPS Director or Deputy Director
- Mike is a certified arborist, done work in the city since many years, had own landscape company. Tree enthusiast.
- Worked for Parks since 2016 doing all the tree work, tree warden for Parks
- This would expand his role to street trees too for a stipend, working with Tree Commission
- He wants to make sure we don't just cut trees but care for them.
- Trees need a lot of maintenance and many requests come in from residents. The work order system for trees will be integrated with DPS/Parks system
- Different rules: Parks & Street Trees. Councillor Wallace would like to see public notice for Park removal trees
- This is a good example of integration of Parks Dept with DPS efficiencies, share equipment, etc.

Action Taken: Approved 3-0

Notes:

- Moved to the area 2 years ago
- 18 assistant Harbor Masters in the city. They work with Harbormaster, and Harbormaster schedules their shifts.
- Jalen has been in the Coast Guard in this area, this new role is a natural transition
- He is available all shifts, duties, whenever needed
- He wants to make sure the public is safe and educated
- He is very familiar with the Merrimack River. He was one of the boat drivers over at the station, and had quite a quite a bit of experience doing surf training and driving through the mouth daily. The river can change very quickly, and he has seen both unfortunate events, and then some successful events where they were able to save people.
- Look into this in the charter, and looking at State law. State law is pretty clear that you can appoint harbor masters. The charter mentioned as an assistant harbor master, but then it goes on to talk about the necessary roles of that position. It sounds like because of their enforcement responsibilities and the other things that that they need to do, it would make sense that you'd have a title of Assistant Harbor Master who takes on those responsibilities. So that that explains why the Harbor Master would need so many different people doing this work, especially the busy harbor like ours with the enforcement and other functions that would require that title.

Action Taken: Collectively Receive & File 3-0

Notes:

- Several years ago the City updated Chapter 12 of the Ordinance, and in Section 12-1.3
 (d)(2), detailed procedures that allow for banner requests in the public right of way.
 According to this section, "The city council may, in addition to Atkinson Common and Fuller Field fence, designate additional areas within public ways where....." Council has never affirmed other locations, but two are routinely used. McCarthy requests that the Council make a formal determination as to the allowed locations of banners, and suggest that, in addition to Atkinson, and Fuller field, the Council add the High Street bridge over Route One, and the fence at the Little River Trailhead.
- Re: Banner Request In accordance with Newburyport Ordinance, Chapter 9, Article II, and Chapter 12, Sec 12-1.3 (d) (2), on behalf of the Port Parks Alliance, McCarthy requests to place a 3' X 5' banner on the High Street bridge during the period Sept 1-15 2023., and take the Mayor's approval as a waiver from this provision.
- Signs on public property fall under this committee. Signs on private property fall under Zoning. There are temporary signs and permanent signs.
- McCarthy likes the banners for advertising because they are temporary. Would like to see ordinance changes Little River & High Street. Discussed where else could put banners.
- Goes on to ask for Port Parks Alliance on High Street come to find out it's a MassDOT approval. No policy, but ordinance says the Mayor can come up with an MOU w/state McCarthy will contact Mayor.
- Advised him to find a sponsoring Councilor to revise ordinance. Can start with banners, or can do other edits to sign ordinance. That would take longer.
- Committee in agreement, will R&F but gage the interest of the full council
