- Treasurer is liaison to committee and in the end Treasurer has full control in the end
- We have a solid Committee meeting and they are meeting quarterly.
  All of them have a financial background.
- Trust is about 7m 10m
- Looking forward 1-3 years. Technology is something that they are looking for. Online payments, etc. More streamlined online processes. They see it on the money side.
- Taxpayers have the tools they need.
- Biggest thing is just stay at 98% collection rate. Improving a little better at managing things.
- Asked if we can consolidate all credit card processing. Would be a challenge is what Julie shared. Try and work in that direction. We have plenty of platforms. There's a lot of keeping track, what dept it's for and where it goes.
- Did talk to some other treasurers and they shared they are facing the same question
