#### ORDR00505 11 13 2023 Gift Acceptance Nock Tennis Courts \$21,195.00

- o KT \$22k is not full design. Partial construction docs
- o KT CPC application being written by school department
- o KT Get the design completed
- o KT If CPA does not approve project, the money would sit in the account until full design
- o KT Add 2 courts
- KT Around \$300k for construction.
- KT Design around \$30 to \$35k
- MW If funding did not come through, we can return the gift. EM
- SZ Accept contingent upon CPC application
- Updated Information from KTurner:
  - The full design fee is estimated at \$38,750. Its true that the amount donated will
    not cover the full CD/bid set, so we would not enter into a contract to begin
    design unless we are awarded the CPC grant.
  - The number of courts that are desired are 3, not 2.
  - The early estimates for the 3 courts is \$544,000. This includes some grading work (short retaining wall) that would need to be installed to level that space. Once we have a design, value engineering will be more clear.
- o Amendment is "Gift is accepted contingent upon CPA funding approval"
- AK/MW Motion to approve contingent upon CPC approval. 3-0
