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OTHER BUDGET CONSIDERATIONS

NEASC Re-accreditation Preparation	The high school will begin the self-study for re-accreditation next school year. Funding will include stipends to support teacher co-chairs to lead the self-study.
Math/Science Tutor	This position will allow us to create math/science tutoring lab connected with our academic support and learning lab programs.
PSAT 10 + 11	This is one facet of the NHS college and career plan. By administering the PSAT yearly, the school will be able to reflect on the strength of its curriculum as well encourage students taking more advanced courses before graduating.
Technology Integration Specialist	For the past 2 years, NHS has explored possible models for a 1:1 computer device program. The addition of this position will support professional development around these goals in reimagining educational technology.
