Chicane examples-Google maps. <u>Diane Gagnon-</u> ODNC 119 Amend Ch 13 Sec 168 Plummer Ave Restricted Parking.

<u>Councillor Wallace</u>- ODNC00119_7_11_2022 - Amend Ch 13 Sec 168 Plummer Ave Restricted Parking. Good traffic calming plan, Recommends Ord. Change to Plummer Ave Concept Plan Approves crosswalks at entrance and bump outs. Safety zone concerns

<u>Councillor Donahue-</u>Clarification on Handicap spots. Resident request? Close to ramp for School. Appv. Bump outs. Shortening distance of crosswalks. Councillor Wallace-Ord For Handicap Space- for Public Safety.

<u>Councillor Donahue</u>-Questions emails from residents after site visit. Chicanes? Diane Gagnon- Most residents agreed. Trial runs.

<u>Councillor Preston-Supports Traffic Calming plan/Chicanes.</u> Lost parking spots? Stated 44. What is the opposition for Chicanes? City should prepare for more request.

<u>Councillor McCauley-Public Safety Chair</u>-opened meeting for Public Safety regarding Plummer Avenue.

<u>Councillor Wright</u> -requested more explanation how test runs will be done. <u>Jon-Eric White</u>-Basic vertical post along where curbing will be. Five Chicanes long section (2) short section. Middle planters or barrel. Temporary pave markings to get full effect.

Don't agree with bump outs

<u>Councillor Wright</u>- How will this work around plowing.

Jamie Tuccolo- PBC/plastic only temporary- To be used Spring, Summer and Fall.

<u>Councillor McCauley</u>-Whole street. Drop off zone approves. No parking needs to amend to Variable parking. Introducing test for traffic calming. Chicanes with line in the street for education. Parking on one side. Road markings critical. In favor of bump out at Atkinson playground. Residents have critical voice.

Jamie Tuccolo- Suggest trial run, paint in the road for Winter.

<u>Councillor McCauley</u>- Chicanes would be painted out and center line moved to mirror traffic.

<u>Councillor Wallace-</u> opened meeting for Public comment.

<u>Councillor Donahue</u>- stated in favor of plan. Encourage Public comments. -<u>Public Comment-Barbara Keller</u>-11 Plummer Ave-Concerns Extending school zone. Chicanes and Bike lanes.

Councillor McCauley-Expanding safety zone -20MPH -No bike lanes. Councillor Wallace- Will have trial runs to make sure works out. Councillor Wallace question for Public Safety across from School, Where is the no parking? Diane Gagnon-after ramp no parking sign during School hours. To direct traffic smaller Chicane at School drop off zone. Councillor McCauley- Ordinance states variable parking, not during school time/drop off zone. Public Comment Doyle- Sidewalk concerns five feet wide. What is the plan for the trees. Jamie Tuccolo-Intent not to move curb, will build around trees. Part of reconstruction. Jon-Eric White- ADA- replace in-kind generally 5 feet wide- allow 3 feet at signs. Councillor Wallace- Chicanes and traffic calming will be safer. Councillor McCauley- will have consistency in parking signs East & West. only during School hours allow for parking when not on session. Councillor Wallace-And there will open parking spots during School time.
