Can either of you confirm whether or not AJH has received DPS approval for use of the Perry Way cul-de-sac as a landing spot in the coming year while they relocate the hospital's existing landing pad? We've been provided with approval from the Fire Dept. and MedFlight, but I want to know that DPS (which has jurisdiction over public ways) has approved this. Neither the Fire Dept. nor Medflight can give AJH unilaterally approval without DPS review. Please advise if there are any issues. The City Council is looking to approve a related Special Permit (for their expansion project that displaces the existing on-site pad temporarily) Monday night. Thanks!
