APPT 484 Tom Baillie – W/S Commission Alternate

Mr Baillie came before the committee to discuss his nomination. He's been a resident for 5 years or so, his background is in construction and civil engineering. APPT 496 Adam Armstrong – reappointment to the Harbor Commission

Adam came before the committee to discuss his nomination. This is a re-appointment, and he mentioned what an interesting learning curve in his first term. He worked on the recent dredge and the side-dredge and he worked cross border with Salisbury. He currently is engaged with a semi-regional group called "8 towns and the Great Marsh"...leading efforts to help save the marshes and their relationships to the river and oceans. He's also been involved in stationing a weather buoy outside the mouth of the river which can provide critical info for boaters, and CSO counts/alerts. He looks forward to continuing supporting the forward progress of Harbormaster Hogg. Committee voted 3-0 to support this reappointment.

ODNC171 Amend Ch13 to move a Handicap Parking Space on Pleasant St

This order is to move a handicap space on Pleasant St 20 feet so as to place an already approved new crosswalk across Pleasant at the end of Inn St, in front of Oregon's and NuKitchen.
