SUMMARY:** The City of Newburyport will improve the resilience of Newburyport’s Wastewater Treatment Facility to effects of various climate change stressors. The project will involve performing a detailed climate risk assessment to the various components within the wastewater facility, identifying solutions to reduce flood risk, and creating a roadmap with timeline for implementing these solutions.
