Hi,  
We had this on our agenda last night and the Commission issued a “Negative Determination of Applicability” which essentially is an approval of the work. They filed a Request for Determination of Applicability (RDA) rather than a NOI for this project because of the minimal amount of work in Nbpt, all of which is in the outer part of the 100 –foot buffer zone of wetlands that lie in Newbury. The area of work is already disturbed and all drainage is directed to Newbury. Therefore, the Commission determined that there would be no adverse impacts from the proposed work and issued a Negative Determination. Meaning also that a NOI is not required. I hope that helps clarify! 😊
