Please note that the applicant, Bavaro Family Realty Two, has submitted a final sent of revised plans. As a reminder, there is a mixed-use building being proposed by the applicant which currently under review in the town of Newbury where the building will be located. Four of the proposed parking spots associated with the new building will be in the city of Newburyport. The only review required under the Newburyport Zoning Ordinance is that of minor site plan review based on the fewer than 10 parking spaces associated with a new Use. The parking is accessory to the primary Use that lies within the town of Newbury.

The following revisions have been made in response to City comments and LSP review:

- The fire service has been revised to specify DR18 HDPE pipe in 40' lengths with fused joints
- The fire hydrant has been changed to "non-draining"
- Note 5 in the "Water Installation Notes" has been added requiring all trenched for utilities to be lined with filer fabric and backfilled with clean material
- The exit from the site has been modified to provide an 18' wide drive
- Utilities have been revised per DPS comment
