# 2 Jackson Street, Newburyport Background


### Background

- Commission viewed prior plans on November 12, 2020 meeting:
  - Commission discussed proposed dormer;
  - Requested applicant review existing plans to see if they could either bring dormer into compliance or closer to compliance with city Ordinance; and
  - Instituted demolition delay.
- Purpose of dormer is to obtain safer access to third floor of home and make use of space within a small footprint.
- Home has 1,338 square feet of living area on a 1,848 square foot lot.
- Cannot meet all guidelines and obtain safe access to third floor.


# 2 Jackson Street, Newburyport Updated Plans


### **Updated Plans**

- Balance of achieving safer access to third floor and a modest increase in living space with the least impactful means.
- Original proposal was a shed dormer even with roof ridge and plane of wall.
- Compare with currently proposed dormer:
  - Top is dropped 1 foot below roof ridge;
  - Dormer is now setback 5'1/2" from the front elevation of the house and not detracting from the original form of the front gable; and
  - Also dropped exposed front of dormer from 5'3/4" to 4'7" to provide lower exposure to the street.
- Chimney will remain. Will appear in all drawings.
