
44 High Street Overview

- Roof change on one-story section located at rear of single-family residence which is proposed to be demolished.
- Construction of addition comprising of one- and two-stories at rear constituting a roof line change.
- Neither the existing section to be demolished or the proposed new section will be visible from High Street.
- Due to tree coverage, landscaping, a residence on an abutting property to the east, and a shed in the back yard, it is unlikely the addition will be more than minimally visible from Bromfield Street.


44 High Street Historical Overview

- Structure constructed in 1850 according to District Date Sheet and 1889 according to Assessor Record.
- No Form B available.
- Portion of the one-story section dates back to at least 1906 per 1906 and 1914 Sanborn maps.
- In 2001, one-story addition constructed off existing one-story section as reflected by building permit information available on MIMAP.
 - This addition is not shown in 1995 Recorded Site Plan.
- Proposed demolition includes both parts of the one story section.

































