- 1. The sidewalk is brand new asphalt due to the Merrimac St project. Jamie you can decide if you want the developer to upgrade to cement or brick. The site includes a brand new cement cross walk to the east end of Christie Dr as well.
- 2. The site has room for 3 trees. The trees must be small due to the presence of overhead wires and the planting strip is very narrow. I would suggest 3 Columnar Sargent Cherries (*Prunus sargentii*) evenly spaced across the front.
