I reviewed the original application for Stanley Tucker which was supplemented by a Stormwater report dated May 12, 2020

I reviewed the original application for Malcolm Hoyt Drive and my comments are attached

I contacted Peter Ogren and plan revisions were made to address my comments. Revised Stormwater calculations dated May 12, 2020 were reviewed. The outstanding issues listed in my review, Stormwater, Water Quality, correct Landscape Plan and address erosion and sedimentation control were addressed in the revisions. I also spoke to the owner concerning the size of the expansion compared to the size of the existing storage on Malcolm Hoyt Drive and was concerned that the increase in storage would mean increased inventory and thus potentially increased inventory.
