- Recommended a conversation with Dave Zink regarding the upgrade of our overhead lighting preferably with LED bulbs.
- The Hallway wall repair will be done asap.

The need for an outside handicap parking space by the ramp was discussed. Heather Rowe stated that the request needs approval by the City Council. She will take care of that.

A request was made for mail boxes for both the tenant and Emma.
