#### **Issues**

Inn Street signage wording approval

The commission reviewed wording and design for the Inn Street Fountain signage warning people to stay off the columns and other required postings. **Motion to approve the Inn Street Fountain signage** by Commissioner Turner, seconded by Commissioner Popken. So voted on a unanimous voice vote.

Rail Trail seating – granite blocks as bench replacements

Commissioners discussed a proposal to use granite blocks in lieu of benches when a bench breaks on the Clipper City Rail Trail. Commissioners advised replacing broken benches with the same bench.

Receive correspondence – pickle ball proposal

The commission received a proposal to install a pickleball court. Motion to table the proposal by Commissioner Dykes, seconded by Commissioner Turner. So voted on a unanimous voice vote.

Re-design of Three Roads Intersection Plantings

Commissioners asked that Friends of Newburyport Trees and Tree Commission to review a planting plan and costs for the three roads intersection plantings.
