

PUBLIC MEETING

Residential Parking Program **Prospect Street between Fruit Street & Federal Street**

January 16, 2019, 7:00 p.m.
Newburyport Public Library, Children's Program Room

Since 1994, an increasing number of streets located within two blocks of State Street have been added to the City's **Residential Parking Program**.

- Within residential parking zones, curbside parking is limited to two (2) or four (4) consecutive hours between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, unless the vehicle has a residential parking permit.
- Anyone age 17 or higher who resides within a residential parking zone may obtain at no-cost a residential parking permit for his or her block.
- Each household may obtain one (1) visitor parking permit, at no cost.

In December 2018, the City Council voted to add Prospect Street between Fruit Street and Federal Street to the Residential Parking Program. **Enforcement is suspended to allow block residents to discuss the change.**
